**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC)  
(LOCKDOWN) (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) ORDER, 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Regulations, 2020, I HEREBY make the following Order —

**1. Citation.**

This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) (Lockdown) (Amendment)(No. 2) Order, 2020.

**2. Amendment of order 3 of the principal Order.**

Order 3 of the principal Order is amended in paragraph (5)(b), by the deletion of the number “5” and substitution of the number “6”.

**3. Amendment of order 6 of the principal Order.**

Paragraph (1) of order 6 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) in subparagraph (a), by the deletion of subsubparagraph (i);
- (b) in subparagraph (i), by the deletion of the full stop and the substitution of a semicolon; and
- (c) by the insertion immediately after subparagraph (i) of the new subparagraph (j) —
  - “(j) grocery stores whether wholesale or retail may operate and open to the general public on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.”.

**4. Amendment of order 8 of the principal Order.**

Paragraph (1) of order 8 of the principal Order is amended by the insertion immediately after subparagraph (d) of the following new paragraph —

- “(e) gas stations,”.

**5. Revocation and replacement of order 11 of the principal Order.**

Order 11 of the principal Order is revoked and replaced as follows—

**“11. Undertakings and activities in Abaco and its Cays.**

- (1) Notwithstanding order 3, the following businesses, undertakings and activities in Abaco are permitted to continue in operation —
  - (a) gas stations, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of refuelling generators;
  - (b) non-governmental organisations for the production and provision of water and food distribution;
  - (c) for reconstruction generally;
  - (d) restaurants utilizing takeaway and curbside only from Monday to Friday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. And 7:00 p.m.; and
  - (e) grocery stores from Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. And 5:00 p.m.
- (2) Notwithstanding order 6, a hardware store or pharmacy currently operating from the premises of a grocery store may continue to operate from within the grocery store and is not restricted to operating utilizing curbside pickup and delivery.”.
